The goal of this course is twofold: (1) to produce complete and potentially publishable pieces of writing; (2) to design and produce a magazine of students' course work.

The students then produce original works, which subsequently are student edited for inclusion in the seminar magazine. All writing assignments are pre-determined by the instructor.

Students must do required writing assignments, research and reading for each class.

Scene Story: descriptive story based on real-time observation Profile story: The Biographical Story

Trend Story: The Review

Immersion Story: The Interview & Character Sketch

The Personal Essay

Travel writing

Flash fiction and poetry

Advertisements

Magazine style reviews: page make-up and design

No textbook. Student research and writing will be supplemented with handouts, instruction and reading materials provided by the instructor.
