"5 Faculties/departments with "O" in the "English proficiency test requirements" column require each candidate to submit their test score for either one of the English language proficiency tests marked "O" by the faculty/department. Faculties/departments that have the column crossed out do not require English proficiency test scores.

"6 Candidates will be asked to complete a brief pre-interview questionnaire on the day of the interview.

"7 The Japanese essay will be used as reference material for the interview.

"8 From AY2014, the Course of Plant Clinical Science is scheduled to become an independent department constituting one of the three departments under the Faculty of Bioscience and Applied Chemistry (notification documentation for the establishment of the department has been submitted to the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology).
