

Against Coronavirus Infection (COVID-19) Hosei University Graduate School Emergency Support Scholarship Application Guideline (in October)

"Hosei University Graduate School Emergency Support Scholarship" was the system established for the support to the graduate students who are in financial distress due to the recent spread of coronavirus infections (COVID-19).

1. Eligibility

Students enrolled in the master's program, doctoral program, or professional degree program of Hosei University Graduate School (excluding 研修生, 研究生, etc.).

However, those who fall under the following are excluded.

- ① Those who are on leave this year (annual, spring semester, fall semester).
- ② Those who do not pay their own tuition fees (The students those receives scholarships offered by Japanese government or foreign government sponsors and pays tuition fees and those who are exempt from tuition fees stipulated in the Article 25, Paragraph 2 of the Hosei University Degree Regulations, etc.).
- ③ Those who receive this scholarship in June application period.
- ④ Other benefit-type scholarships / subsidy recipients.

In 2021, those who receive this scholarship will be disqualified from applying for the university's scholarships and the external scholarships (that do not allow double scholarships).

- a The recipients of this scholarship cannot receive other university's scholarships
 - Hosei University Centennial Graduate School Master's course Scholarship recipients
 - Students can apply both for the Hosei University Graduate School "Doctoral Course Research Grant" (Application period: October, Payment time: Mid-January, Benefit amount: 320,000 yen for liberal arts, 480,000 yen for science) and this scholarship, however, recipients of the "Doctoral Course Research Grant" will be unqualified for this scholarship.
- b The recipients of this scholarship cannot receive the external scholarships (that do not allow double scholarships).

If you are receiving or applying for the external scholarship at the time of applying for this scholarship and you become recipient of both, you will have to choose either one.

2. Benefit criteria

Applicants must meet the following conditions:

- ① For applicant who is a Head of household (Those who live alone are heads of households.)
Meet both of the followings;
 - a An annual salaried income of less than 1,300,000 and not received high remittance for living expenses from your family in 2020
 - b Due to the spread of the new coronavirus infection, it was difficult to increase income by October 2021.

- ② For applicant who is a Non-head of household
Total household income in 2020 has decreased by more than 30% compared to 2019, and as of October 2021, there is no prospect of improvement.

※ Students who are living separately from their family and students themselves or their family are bearing the rent for the students are regarded as a head of household.

※ In all cases, priority is given to those who are receiving, applying for, or receiving a loan scholarship from the Japan Student Services Organization, those who received it last year, or those who are using a student loan.

3. **Number of Recipients**

40 students

4. **Amount of Benefit (yearly)**

All Graduate Schools and Professional Degree Program 100,000 yen

5. **Application Period**

October 25, 2021 (MON.) 10:00 to November 30, 2021 (TUE.) 17:00

6. **Application Method**

- If you send a photo, please use your student ID number and name as the file name.
- Even if you have already applied for this scholarship in June, please submit the required documents when applying for this application period in October.

【Required Documents】

- ① Economic status confirmation (Form I)
- ② Recommendation letter from your Supervisor (Form II)
- ③ Documents showing that you are using or applying for an education loan (※Applicable student only)
- ④ Certificate of Residence / JUMIN HYO (In the case of a head of household, only the applicant is listed, and in the case of a non-head of household, all households are listed, but the registered domicile and my number are not listed. Also, those issued after April 2021 (copy is acceptable))

【In case that the applicant is Head of household (Those who live alone are heads of households.)】

- ⑤ Income Certificates (a copy of income and withholding tax certificate, a copy of tax exemption certificate, etc.) for 2019 and 2020 for All Households
- ⑥ Information on the amount of remittance for living expenses from your family from April 2020 to March 2021 (copy of bankbook, etc.)
- ⑦ A copy of the lease agreement for your apartment (Students who are living separately from their family only)

【In case that the applicant is Non-head of householder】

- ⑤ Income Certificates for 2019 and 2020 for All Households

7. **Announcement of the Results and Scholarship Payments (Schedule)**

The results will be announced in the notification on Hoppii in around mid-January, 2022 and scholarships will be paid at the end of February, 2022.

8. **Notes**

- ① If the information is false, the full amount of the scholarship must be refunded.
- ② The recipients will be decided based on the degree of economic impact of the applicant.
- ③ As a result of screening, you may not be selected.
