Request for infection control measures

- ① We take your body temperature. If your body temperature is 37.5°C (99.5°F) or over, will not be allowed to take the health checkup.
 - ② Please keep wearing a mask during the checkup at the site.
 - ③ Before entering the reception room, please disinfect your hands with alcohol sanitizer.
- * For infection prevention, we may leave windows open for a while to promote ventilation in the room.
- * If you have had cold symptoms such as fever, cough, sore throat, diarrhea, nausea, strong fatigue or feel loss of sense of taste or smell, or you are concerned about your physical condition, please prioritize medical treatment.

4. What to bring on the day

2) HB pencil or Mechanical pencil, Eraser

3) Plain T-shirt (* Used when taking chest X-rays)

4) *Glasses/Contact lenses (if you usually wear them: bring or wear them)

*4th year, graduate and professional school students only

5) Mask

5. Medical checkup contents

1 st / 2 nd / 3 rd year students	Chest X-ray, height/weight, physical examination
4 th year/graduate	Chest X-ray, height/weight, physical examination, eyesight

* Male and female students will be examined in separate areas. Partial disrobing will be required for some tests.

* You can consult regarding the health examination (e.g., individual support) in advance if necessary.

6. Notes

- 1) It is strongly recommended that students planning to take a Health and Physical Education Field Class undergo the health examination.
- 2) “Medical checkup contents” should be taken in the grade on the day of the examination.
- 3) Anyone not undergoing the 2025 health examination at the university or missing any of its contents will not be issued the “health certificate” that may be necessary for job hunting, participation in practical training, and other procedures.
- 4) For the chest X-ray, wear clothes that you can easily change(*one-piece dress is unsuitable) and underwear without buttons or metal parts.
Remove any necklaces and magnetic therapy devices and tie up hair away from the back.
- 5) Please turn off your cellular phones or set them to silent during the checkup at the site.
- 6) No locker facilities are available; you must take responsibility for your own belongings. **Don't bring any valuables.**
