1. If the dissertation has not yet been published online, please indicate the expected date of publication.
 2. Please state a reason why an abridged version will be published instead of the full text.
 3. If the dissertation is published in print and its abridged version is released online instead, you will be required to notify by (1) publishing the dissertation or (2) submitting publication plan (e.g. a copy of agreement with a publisher etc.) within a year after the degree has been conferred. If you default on this, the complete version will be published.
 4. Even in cases where only a summary of the dissertation is published online, the full text will be made available for viewing upon request at the University Library and the National Diet Library.
